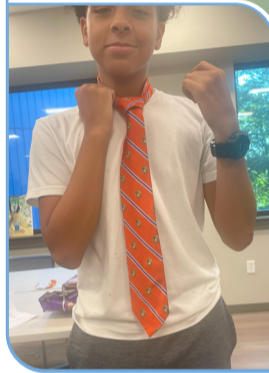

**75%** of youth in VISIONS earned a workplace credential and felt more confident & knowledgeable

### Mentoring

**276** students received **MENTORING** in school

Students' average satisfaction rating with their mentor: **10** out of 10



**100%** - improved social skills

### Community Youth Centers

**8,953** visits to centers

youth that improved their confidence **over 80%**

**over 85%** of youth found the program to be helpful



### Community Service

#### 4-H/Middle Earth Student Ambassadors of Community Health



- worked to address littering and garbage problems in their community.
- organized and implemented a community clean-up day in Bound Brook. Collected over 30 bags of litter.
- created PSA's to increase usage of garbage bins.

#### Station House Adjustment Program



**70** teens completed **822** hours of mandatory community service as a consequence for a minor offense

parents rated the program **5 out of 5**

**100%** did not have further police contact

**23%** increase in how likely youth are to volunteer in future



### 21st CCLC Afterschool Program

**213** students served



**85%** of students felt that they were able to complete their homework everyday and received help with difficult assignments.



**over 90%** of parents believed their child was safer after school and learning new skills and discoveries. **95%** believed the program had a positive impact on their family.
